EVENT SCHEDULE:

1. Outhouse entry registration and inspection, 8:30 a.m. – 9:45 a.m. in front of the Coopersville Farm Museum (375 Main Street). Must be in line for parade by 9:45 a.m.
2. National Anthem by Thom Eno, Parade and announcements of the outhouse teams will begin promptly at 10 a.m.
3. Races will begin immediately following the parade
4. Heat elimination times determine placement
5. At the conclusion of the races, teams will line up their outhouses along Main Street for an official trophy and award presentation. Photos may also be taken at this time by local media and promotions organizations.

The "Outhouse 500" is a fun, community event organized by several community businesses, organizations, and individuals and hosted by the Coopersville/Polkton Firemen's Club.

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS - 2017

“Outhouse 500” 2017
Coopersville, Michigan
Waiver & Release (hold harmless)

STRUCTURE:

1. Outhouses must have four (4) walls, a roof, a doorway with a crescent moon shape on the front door. Door must be secured OPEN during the race. No weight requirement. Absolutely NO riders allowed.
2. Outhouse must be a minimum of nine (9) square feet at its base, and a maximum overall width not to exceed six (6) feet (including grasping and/or pushing devices). Minimum height of five (5) feet from the floor to the highest point of the roof is required.
3. Any number of wheels and any size wheels may be used.
4. Any device for grasping (to move) the outhouse may be used except ropes (or like materials/ devices). All grasping devices must be secured solid.
5. Outhouse may be built of any solid material, and structurally sound enough not to fall apart during the race.
6. No glass may be used.
7. Each outhouse must have a “name”; the name is to be displayed on each side of the outhouse (front and back is also allowed). Sponsors names may be applied anywhere on the outside of the outhouse.
8. At least 2 (two) people must push, with feet on the ground, the outhouse down the street.

TEAM:

1. A team shall consist of a maximum of five (5) people. At least two (2) of which must push the outhouse.
2. A helmet is recommended for all team members
3. No riders allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. No axle-type structures (bicycle, etc.) NOEXCEPTIONS.
5. A team shall dress in ‘like’ apparel. Each team and outhouse should have a “theme” and dress accordingly.

Each team must have a representative carry a flag for their outhouse during the parade.

PRIZES:

1. Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams determined by fastest race time fol-

- lowing the competition.
2. Most Creative Award to most unique outhouse.
 3. “Spirit” Award to team that shows the most spirit relating to their “theme.”

RACE:

1. Races are by elimination run in heats of three (3) at a time
2. Heat competitors will be determined by number drawing and placed in brackets
3. Race course is 500 feet
4. The course will be divided into two (2) lanes. No outhouse may go into another’s lane
5. No deliberate sabotage to another team or it will be an automatic disqualification.
6. All outhouses are to be human-powered by foot to ground (run) racing. No motors or pedal powered units will be allowed.
